EMER-N (Portugal)

- -Encourage the creation of small and micro businesses in rural mountainous areas
- -Offers support create a business
- -Already 344 companies in Northern Portugal have received support (400 jobs)
- Dates: 2016-2018
- Funding: European Regional Development Fund





agricing Martin Land Call

Aragón Retorno Joven (region Aragon, Spain)

- -Facilitates the return of young Aragonese who have left the territory due to the lack of jobs
- -Connects young people with companies
- -332 young people have returned to settle in the region since the programme creation
- -Exists since 2018
- -Budget (for 2018-2022): 2.509.500 euros from the region





Martin Low Con (D)

"Stay in the countryside – it pays off" (Poland)

- Encourages young people to stay in rural areas by promoting the funds & opportunities they can access through rural development funds
- -4 mountain regions: Małopolskie, Świętokrzyskie and Podkarpackie and Lubelskie.
- -Date: 2018
- -Funding: support & funding from the Polish national rural network

Desafio - rural internship programme (region Aragon, Spain)

- Proposes to Zaragoza University student internships in rural areas
- Programmes covers daily allowance / travel costs / accommodation & more
- -Part of an overall strategy against depopulation of the Chair on Depopulation
- -Since 2018
- -Others: ODISSEU (Catalonia), InSite (France)

► Go remote project (HR, BG, FI, NO, LV, IS)

- Aims to reduce youth unemployment by promoting the opportunities offered by remote working
- -Offers training for specific promising sectors and training in teleworking
- -Date: since 2022
- Funding: €1.168.039 grant from Iceland, Liechtenstein and Norway through the EEA and Norway Grants Fund
