Recap

- 1st meeting
 - Changing definitions to include landscape features in CAP eligible ha
 - Mapping / remote sensing for more detailed data & LF inventory – important for monitoring
 - Green Architecture
 - Clarity of non-productive areas definition, e.g. conditionality
 - Types of LF included under result / impact indicators
 - Incentivise uptake, e.g. results-based initiatives, long-term schemes, paying for ecosystem services (possible through eco-schemes)
 - Cooperation amongst farmers & bottom-up approaches to knowledge sharing, project design, etc.
 - Training and advice important, tailored to farm context
