Reusable packaging in the European fresh supply chain.

Sustainability agreement between the Belgian Feed sector and the Flemish government


The feed sector committed to produce feed with a lower amount of phosphorus and nitrogen.



The Enteric Emission Agreement in Flanders: Flemish Government and cattle industry

The agreement recognises that methane emissions need to be reduced by almost 30% by 2030.


