WHAT IS ERASMUS FOR NEW ENTREPRENEURS?

- Successful Cross-Border Business Exchange Programme **part funded** by the EC between 1-6 months, across 40 countries since 2009.
- Enables early stage entrepreneurs to exchange skills, knowledge and contacts with more established business owners in another country
- Exchange of experience through peer to peer learning and mentoring
- Understanding & insights into new markets
- Additional "set of hands" for your business







HOW TO QUALIFY

•New Entrepreneurs have less than 3 years experience running a business and have a business plan.

• Host Entrepreneurs have more than 3 years experience running a business and are willing to mentor a new entrepreneur.

GRANT ASSISTANCE

- New Entrepreneur (NE) receives monthly grant payment of between €560-€1,100
- Grant covers travel and subsistence costs incurred during stay abroad
- No cost to the Host Entrepreneur (HE)







PROGRAM SUPPORT OFFICE

- Full facilitation and support provided by your Intermediate Organisation
- Large database of qualified, motivated entrepreneurs and businesses from all sectors
- Workplan agreed in advance by all parties
