

1. Spačva basin forest

- Spačva basin largest integrated complex of lowland pedunculate oak forest in Europe (Klepac 2000)
- Most valuable forest resource in Croatia
- Natura 2000
- 51.000 hectares (40.000 in Croatia/Vukovar-Srijem County)
- 96% of famous Slavonian oak
- lat. quercus robur, cro. hrast
 lužnjak slavonski hrast



2. Vukovar-Srijem County - Land of the Oaks



- Vukovar-Srijem County (NUTS-3)
 - eastern most Croatian county
 bordering with Serbia and Bosnia

and Herzegovina

- 2.448 km2
- forest area 28,3% (69.382 ha)
- 144.438 inhabitants (2021)








