# Forest-specific support

- **Afforestation** & creation of woodland
- **Agroforestry** systems (establishment, regeneration, renovation)
- Prevention and restoration of **forest damage** (forest fires, natural disasters)
- Investments improving **resilience & environmental value** of forest ecosystems
- Investments in forestry **technologies** + processing, mobilising, marketing
- Natura 2000 and Water Framework Directive payments
- **Forest-environmental & climate services** & forest conservation

# Forest non-specific support (horizontal)

- **Knowledge transfer** and information actions
- **Advisory services**, farm management & farm relief services
- Investments in **physical assets** (e.g. forest roads)
- **Co-operation** (including EIP operational groups)

# What is already at hand (2): Other tools

## Rural Revitalisation Platform

- One-stop shop for rural communities, rural project holders and local authorities to collaborate



## Rural Observatory

- Centralise data on rural areas to support policymaking.
