Objectives



Aim: highlight the role of vocational education and training (VET) to enable an **attractive** farming sector ready for the **twin green & digital transition and** identify priorities and successful approaches for the development of the right skill set.

Objectives:

- Identify the changes in **skills needed** in the EU farming sector to address the challenges brought forward by the twin green and digital transition
- Share successful experiences of vocational education and training (VET) for sustainable, digital-ready and resilient farming in the EU, and identify challenges and possible ways forward
- Explore available **tools** to support high quality VET programmes and promote collaboration and synergies to deliver them



Skills for the agro-food sector: key findings

- Low-skilled workforce: 68% of farm managers had only practical experience, but 22% of younger managers got full agricultural training (only 9% in total) - EU 2016
- Skills mismatch: over 40% of agricultural workforce (over/under qualification)
- Lifelong training: low participation of adult agriculture workforce

HU	Making teaching/learning attractive and relevant to students' expectations. Overcome resource limitations (remote learning, availability of equipment)	Training through virtual reality Networking of schools and with local companies
RO	Developing an entrepreneurial mindset , business development (e.g. rural tourism). Integrated learning activities " from farm to fork "	Integrated practical workshops : work-based learning. Local development strategy through agricultural education and training

Make agricultural VET great (again)!

VET as full-fledged agricultural policy tool: help respond the immediate change...and trigger change

- Increasing knowledge connecting actors: data + anticipation (forecast) + strengthen partnerships (e.g. food industry) + focus on 'local' needs
- **Targeting** a large diversity of workforce, occupations and skills: what training for whom? **Territorial** approach (key role of schools + networks)
- **Removing barriers** to learning (e.g. accessibility, infrastructures*...). Wholeof-government approach: **integration** and **synergies**
- Strengthen farm advisory services + peer-to peer learning + make it practical

What's next?

- CAP Strategic Plans: the tools are there, now let's make them work!
- Involve education (public administrations, schools,...) in EIP OGs
- Identify policy **synergies** (e.g. ESF, ERASMUS+ CoVEs...) share examples
- EU skills agenda for agriculture? Build upon the "Skills partnership for the agri-food ecosystem" (Pact for skills), embed best practices into a clear strategy for skills in farming and make the best of all knowledge.
