## **Approaches**

LU: Open the discussion with Farmers
(Revenue). Environment, climate
organisations are very keen to discuss
and put options on the table. There are
already modifications in the eligibility
criteria. Very intense involvement, higher
than before

Group 1

RO: strong mobilisation of stakeholders. Effort of Ministry to increase dialogue and transparency from initial discussion to implementation

DE: Interest because of 1st Pilar, better geographical balance + more people because of online participation. Good balance of information and intervention groups

RO: Online process has made it easier to participate

FR: Multi-level coordination with stakeholders

SE: The process for stakeholders was difficult. Meetings started too early

FR: Regional MA organised their own consultations at regional level > share 1st versions of interventions and present educational info about the new CAP model > easy to explain the new CAP.

DE: Legal uncertainty - needs are different in regionalised level.

DE: EU - national regional level made the discussion very complex + long process + transparency issue SE: no public consultations for the proposal, more in ad hoc basis.

Many organisations sent letters/statements in other ways.

There was no time for public consultations

## Stakeholder Influence

Need for organisational structure to follow the regional and national process

A common framework, a common calendar of CAP design between national and regional level is a must to achieve Strategic Plans

FR: early involvement allows to better understand the proposal, and1st version of CSPs > key success for convenient calendar PL: Bigger interest in consultation with mixed experiences from previous periods. Online consultation brought more people, also for CAP plan > 3 rounds of consultation and remote meetings.

PL: More effective discussions because of remote meetings
