TNC projects in SFC* (March 2023)

- > 240** TNC notifications in SFC, including
 - > 49 notifications with only 1 MS
 - > 14 notifications with UK only
 - > 18 project notifications with status "completed" all others "ongoing"
- > 162*** notifications analysed

Note:

- * SFC: system for electronic exchange of information concerning shared Fund management between Member States and the European Commission
- ** also includes duplicates or multiple notifications for the same project
- *** Projects with at least one partner indicated from another MS




Notified TNC projects (SFC, March 2023)
