- Launched by the Commission Communication in February 2012
- Aim: to stimulate innovation and improve the exchange of knowledge
- Approach: Closing the innovation gap between research, innovation and practice by:
 - using the interactive innovation model (EIP-AGRI operational groups)
 - linking actors via the EU CAP Network (broad range of networking activities and events)

2014-2022


- ✓ 26 Member States + UK, 98 RDPs implementing EIP OGs' "innovative projects"
- √ 3 200 OGs planned; around 2700 OGs running or finished
- ✓ Over 200 multi-actor projects under Horizon 2020
- ✓ A growing and thriving EIP-AGRI network

2023-2027

- ✓ 25 Member States implementing EIP OGs "innovative projects"
- ✓ Over 6 600 OGs' projects planned
- ✓ EUR 9 billion for multi-actor projects under Horizon Europe Cluster 6 "Food, Bioeconomy, Natural Resources, Agriculture and Environment"



- Contribute to the information of the public and potential beneficiaries on the CAP and funding opportunities




- Contribute to monitoring and evaluation capacity and activities;




