



Legal basis

Commission Implementing Decision (EU) 2022/1864 of 5
 October 2022 on setting out the organisational structure and operation of the European CAP network and repealing Implementing Decision 2014/825/EU



Permanent sub-groups

In agreement with the Commission, the Assembly may set up sub-groups on specific thematic strands related to the objectives and the tasks of the European CAP network, including permanent sub-groups on:

- (a) innovation and knowledge exchange;
- (b) LEADER and territorial development; and
- (c) CAP Strategic Plans.



Sub-group on CAP Strategic Plans

- (a) to contribute to improving the quality of the implementation of the CAP Strategic Plans,
- (b) to identify common issues and opportunities in the implementation of various CAP Strategic Plans interventions and needs for the EU CAP network support (capacity building events and other means of support),
- (c) to foster exchange of knowledge and good practices in the implementation of the CAP Strategic Plans,
- (d) to provide input for the work programme of the EU CAP network, in particular of the CAP Implementation Contact Point,
- (e) to follow up the support provided by the EU CAP network



Sub-group on CAP Strategic Plans

Proposed membership: based on the voluntary commitment of Assembly members; maximum number of stakeholders' groups the most relevant for thematic work

- Managing Authorities or Paying Agencies: 27
- National networks: 27
- Advisory service or research bodies: 27
- Union-wide non-governmental organisations: 15

> Members' representatives may be different than in the EU CAP network Assembly



Members:

- eight members from the Assembly;
- four members from each of the permanent sub-groups established by the Assembly;
- two members from the expert group on the implementation of the CAP Strategic Plan Regulation, related to monitoring and evaluation.
- ➤ appointed by the AGRI DG following a proposal of the Assembly, reflecting the geographic and thematic diversity of the members of the European CAP network and based on the voluntary commitment of the proposed members.



Operational SG with tasks:

- preparing and following-up the activities of the European CAP network, in accordance with the strategic framework provided by the Assembly;
- coordinating the thematic strands in accordance with the framework provided by the Assembly and following-up its implementation;
- assessing on an on-going basis the effectiveness and efficiency of the activities of the European CAP network;
- ensuring the coordination of the work of the Assembly with that of other relevant expert groups and committees
- reporting to the Assembly as regards its activities
