1. Project Ungdomsjobb 2022 – Background / Government assignment

1.1. Background / Government assignment

The Swedish government has the last four years (2020-2023) given the Swedish Public Employment Service the assignments;

1. Summer jobs for youths (working period; june – august, mainly ages 15-18 years old) and

2. Jobs for youths (working period; june – december, mainly ages 19-20 years old).

Both **Summerjobs for youths** and **Jobs for youths** have been a part of the projects Ungdomsjobb 2020, Ungdomsjobb 2021, Ungdomsjobb 2022 (and now Ungdomsjobb 2023).

2. Project Ungdomsjobb 2022 – What Municipalities?

2.1. Swedish Public Employment Service assignment

The assignment says that "The purpose is to strengthen the support in areas with socioeconomic challenges. The Swedish Public Employment Service should distribute 100 million kronor (about 9 million Euro) only to municipalities that have regional statistical areas with socioeconomic area type 1 or 2 (on a scale from 1 – 5 according to the DELMOs definition)

Area type 1 – Areas with big socioeconomic challenges

Area type 2 – Areas with socioeconomic challenges

Area type 3 – Socioeconomic mixed areas

Area type 4 – Areas with good socioeconomic conditions

Area type 5 – Areas with very good socioeconomic conditions

2.2. RegSO - Regional statistical areas

Sweden is divided into **3 363 regional statistical areas** with a population between 663 och 22 622 inhabitants. The number of regional statistical areas vary from two till 147 in the **290 Swedish municipalities.**

3. Project Ungdomsjobb 2022 – Reported results

3.1. Reported results - Summer jobs for youths

113 municipalities have had 3 901 Summer jobs for youths at a cost of 33 million kr.

50 percent (1 940) girls and 50 percent (1 961) boys.

Admin costs have been 7 percent.

59 percent (2 312) had their homes in regional statistical areas with area type 1 or 2.

59 procent (2 312 ungdomar) hade sitt boende i regionala statistikområden med områdestyp 1 eller 2. Motsvarande information för flickor/kvinnor är 59 % (1 141 ungdomar) och för pojkar/män 60% (1 171 ungdomar).

3. Project Ungdomsjobb 2022 – Reported results

3.1. Reported results – Jobs for youths

69 municipalities have had 725 Jobs for youths at a cost of 38 million kr.

41 percent (297) girls and 59 percent (431) boys.

Admin costs have been 8 percent.

51 percent (371) had their homes in regional statistical areas with area type 1 or 2.

4. Project Ungdomsjobb 2022 – Lessons learned

4.1. Lessons learned

1. Level of detail of the reports from the municipalities

Some municipalities chose not to take part in Ungdomsjobb 2022 because of the cost of administration for reporting area type of the regional statistical area for every participant to the government.

2. Keep track of the marginal effects of the assignments

If there are many separate assignments simultaneously from the government to many agencies aiming at municipalities and/or individuals with socioeconomic challenges the incentives to change for these municipalities and/or individuals might disappear (for instance some individuals will have negative income effects if they chose to get a job).
