Objectives of the EU CAP Network and national CAP networks

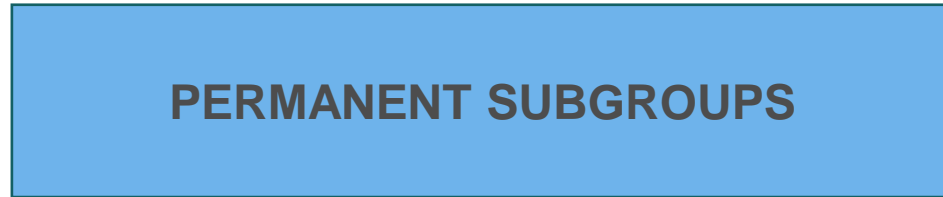
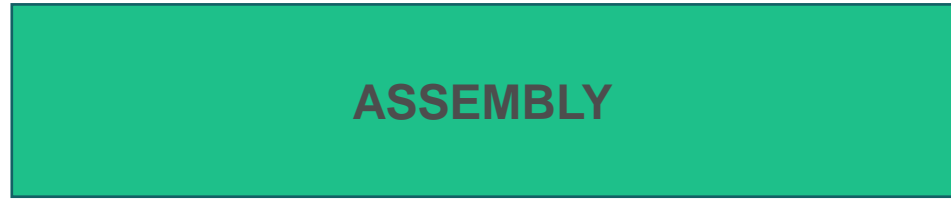
- Increase the involvement of all relevant stakeholders in the implementation/design of CAP SPs

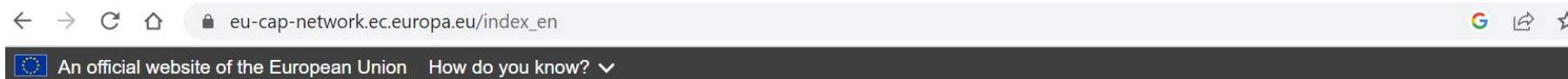
EU CAP Network: governance structure

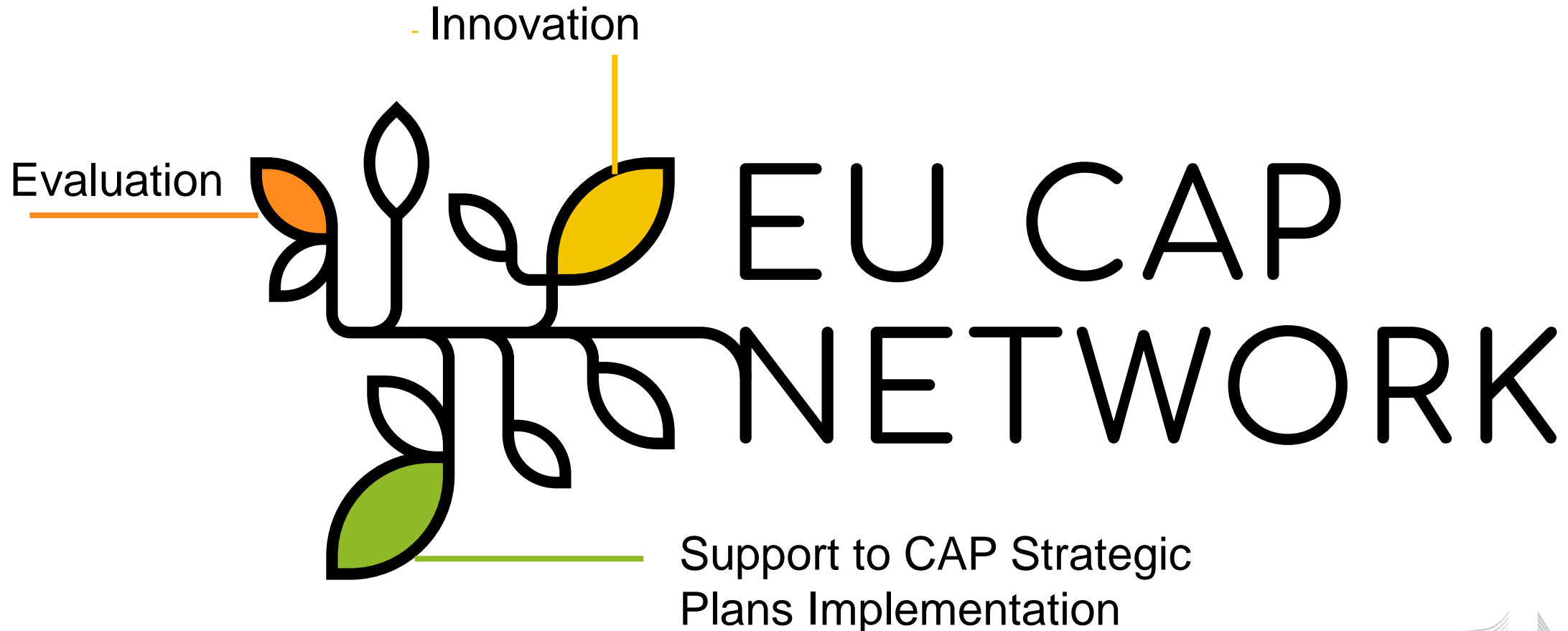

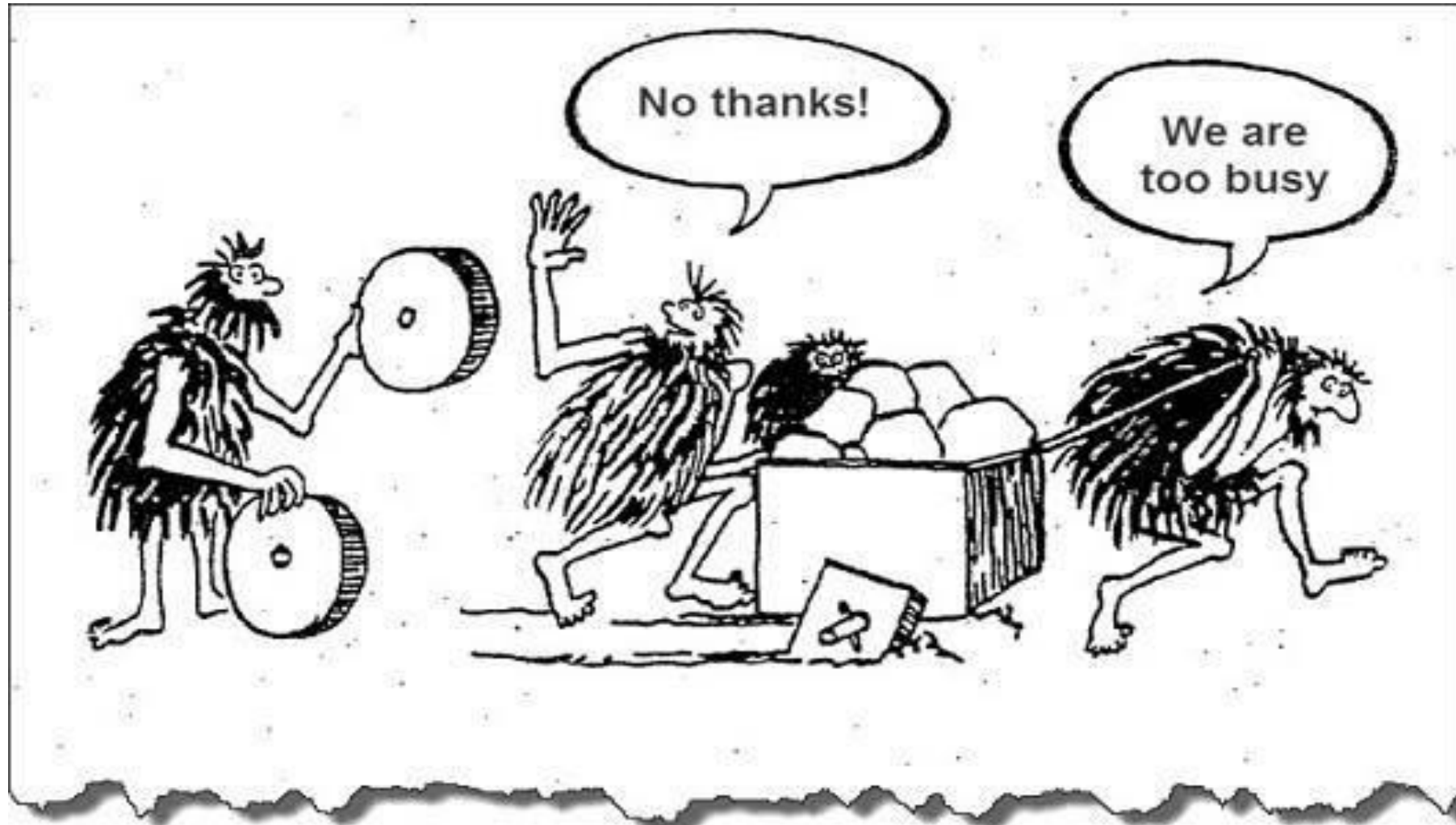

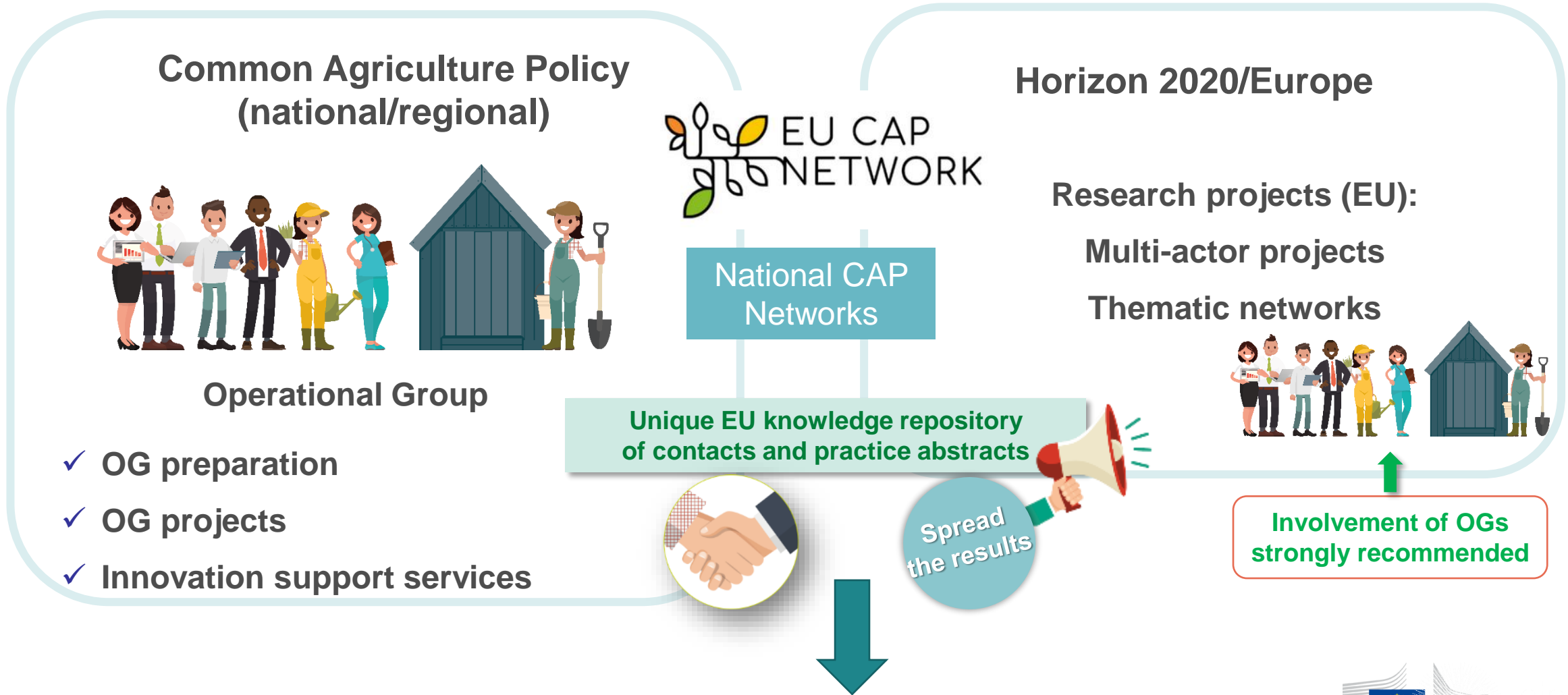
European Innovation Partnership for agricultural productivity and sustainability (EIP-AGRI)

- **Launched** by the Commission Communication in February 2012
- **Aim:** to stimulate innovation and improve the exchange of knowledge
- **Approach:** Closing the innovation gap between research, innovation and practice by:
 - using the **interactive innovation model** (EIP operational groups)
 - linking actors via the **EU CAP Network** (broad range of networking activities and events)

EIP operational groups

- EIP operational groups (OGs) form part of the EIP-AGRI:
 - focusing **on farmers' or foresters' needs** and tackling the interactions across the supply chain where useful
 - bringing together partners with **complementary knowledge**
 - **co-deciding and co-creating** all along the project
- OGs may act at **transnational level**, may be based on traditional practices in a new geographical/environmental context
- OGs disseminate **summaries of plans and results** of their projects, also through the national and European CAP networks

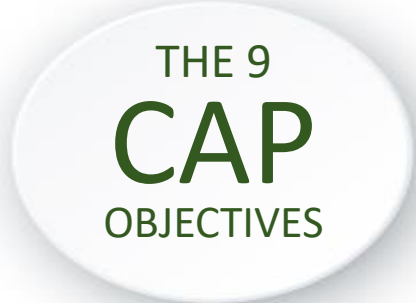


CAP 2023-2027: 9 OBJECTIVES

2014-2022

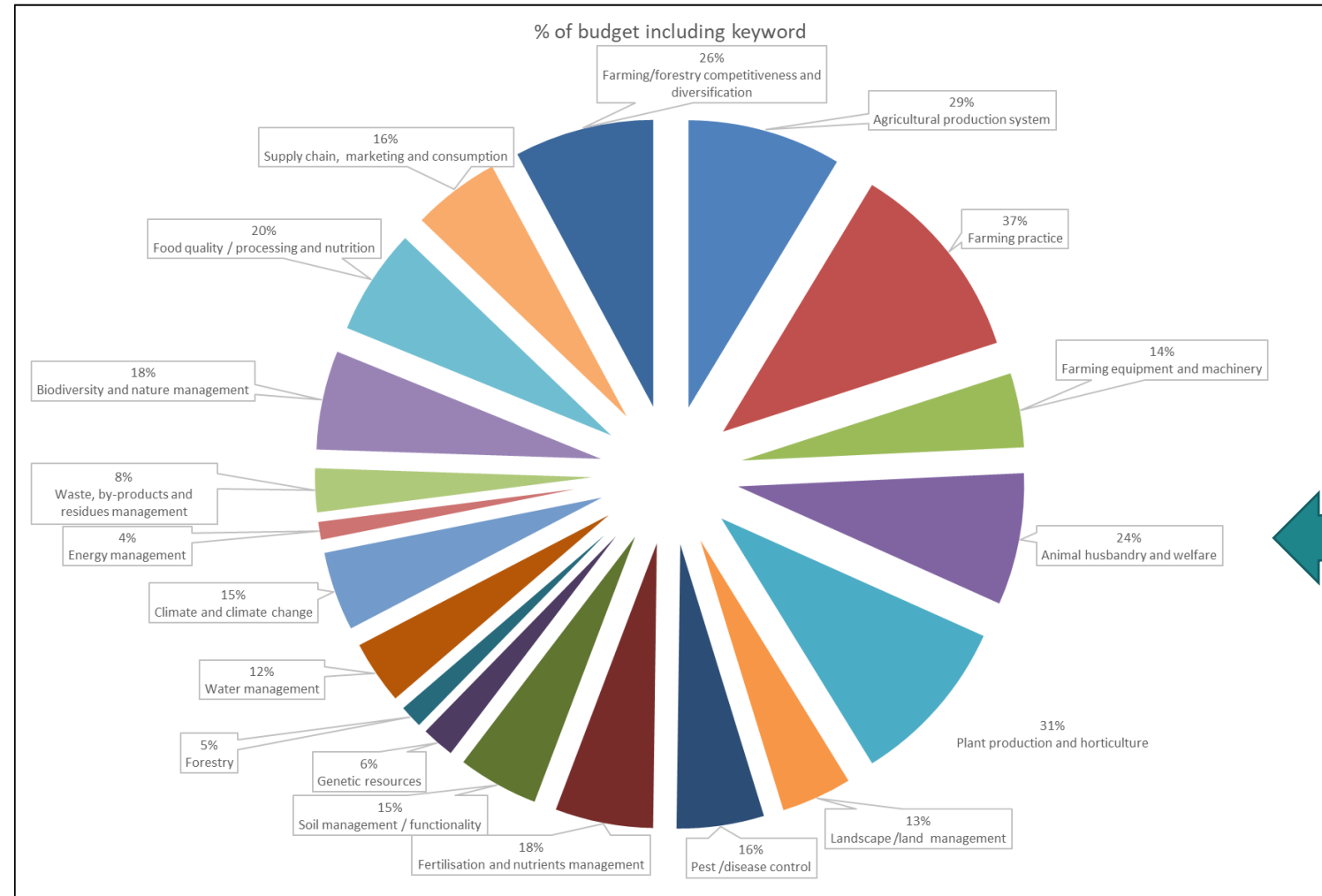
- ✓ **26 Member States**, 98 RDPs implementing EIP OGS' "innovative projects"
