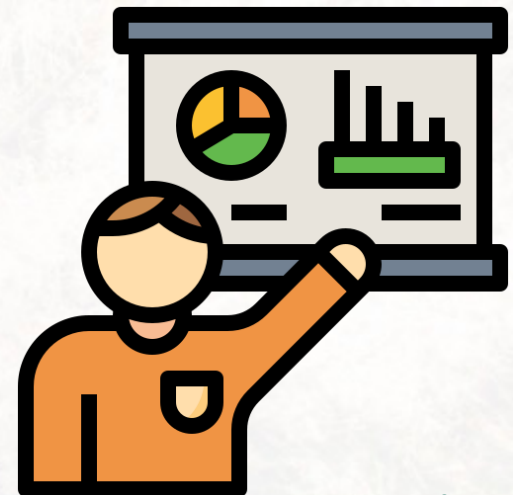

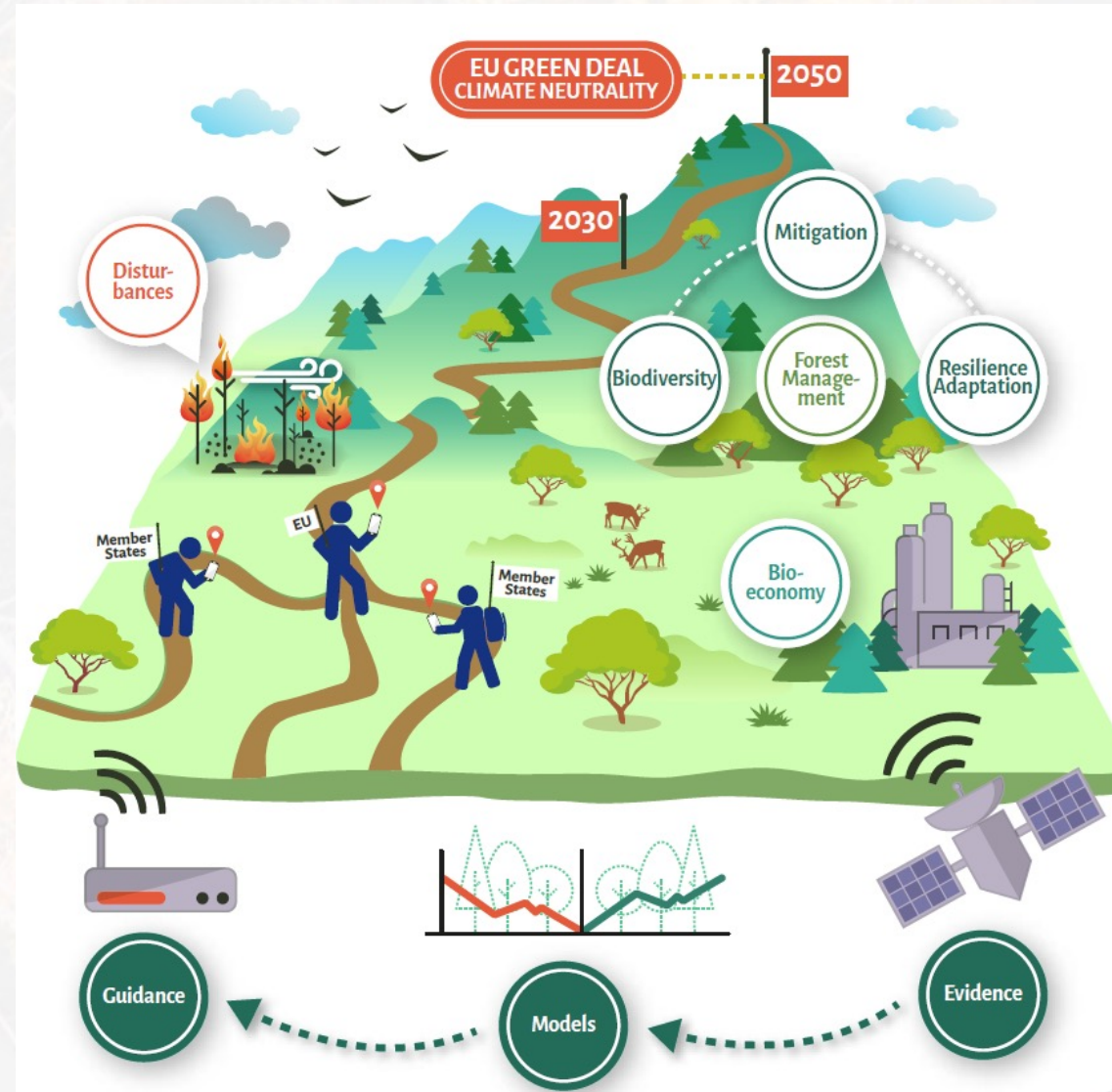

Why stakeholder engagement?



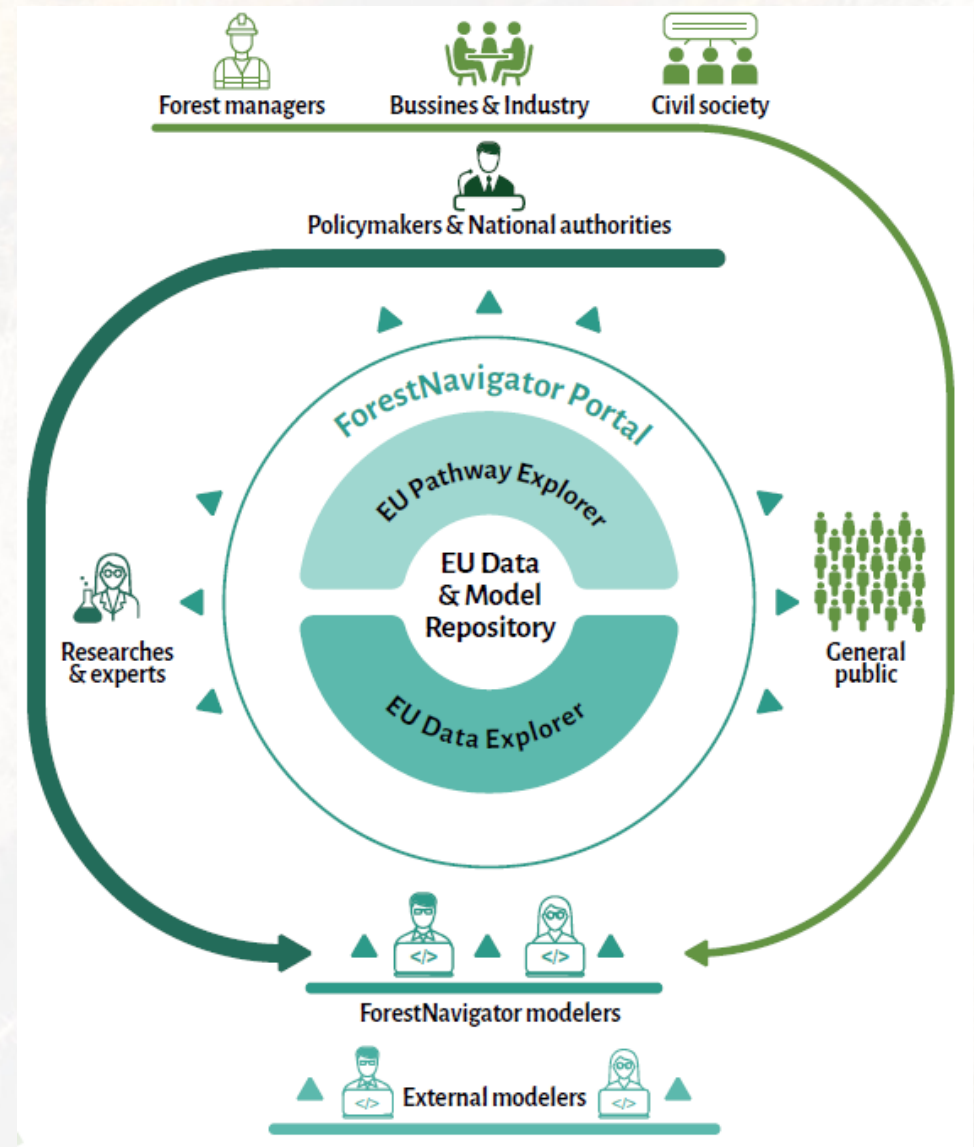
- 🍃 **Alternative forest management** in the different EU regions
 - 🍃 co-benefits in mitigation, adaptation, resilience, and biodiversity
- 🍃 **Recreational and cultural value** of forest areas
- 🍃 **Market scenarios** to represent end uses of wood products
- 🍃 Co-development of the **ForestNavigator Portal**
- 🍃 Feedback on the modeled **forest policy pathways**
