- Focus of the presentation: 2 networks in Belgium



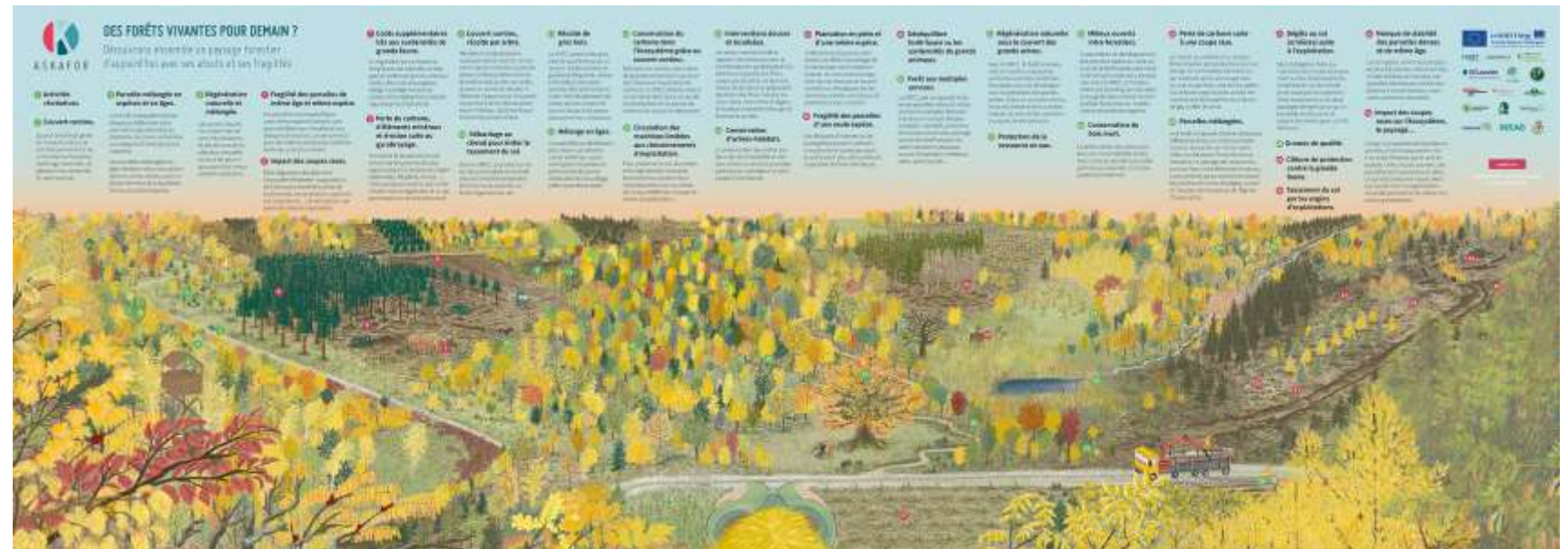
Main outcomes and keys to success
