

- Approach: closing the innovation gap between research, innovation and practice by:





New period, new possibilities

> REGULATION (EU) 2021/2115 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 2 December 2021establishing rules on support for strategic plans to be drawn up by Member States under the common agricultural policy (CAP Strategic Plans) and financed by the European Agricultural Guarantee Fund (EAGF) and by the European Agricultural Fund for Rural Development (EAFRD) and repealing Regulations (EU) No 1305/2013 and (EU) No 1307/2013

> Article 127(3)

EIP operational groups may act at transnational, including cross-border, level.





Cross-visits - definition

A cross-visit between projects is a networking and knowledge exchange activity where Operational Groups projects, working on similar and/or complementary subjects, from a minimum of two different Member States, meet to directly exchange experiences and knowledge.





Goals of cross-visits

- > enable peer-to-peer learning and exchange on the innovations that the involved projects address;
- discuss common challenges and potential solutions;
- > exchange and further disseminate project findings across the EU;
- > establish future collaborations and/or partnerships.
