Networking Objectives

European Agricultural Fund for Rural Development (EAFRD)

(35% of total CAP planned expenditure)

- › AECC –Environment, Climate, animal welfare
- › Areas of Natural Constraint
- › Areas with specific Disadvantages
- › Investments
- › Setting up of farmers & start ups
- › Risk Management tools
- › Co-operation (including LEADER)
- › Knowledge & information
- › Technical Assistance



European Agricultural Guarantee Fund (EAGF)

Direct Payments (62% of total CAP planned expenditure)

- › Basic Income Support for sustainability
- › Coupled Income Support
- › Complementary income support for young farmers
- › Complementary redistributive income support for sustainability
- › Eco-scheme (schemes for climate, the environment & animal welfare)
- › Cotton – Crop specific payment for cotton



European Agricultural Guarantee Fund (EAGF)

› Sectoral Support (3% of total CAP planned expenditure)

- › Apiculture
- › Olive
- › Wine
- › Hops
- › Fruit & Vegetables
- › Others
