

















Inspiring examples: MAA project



- Replacement of Contentious Inputs in Organic Farming Systems (RELACS) fostered the development and facilitated the adoption of cost-efficient and environmentally safe tools and technologies, to phase out the dependency on and use of inputs considered contentious in organic farming systems.
- The project was developed by involving relevant actors from research, farming, advisory services and industry from the very start.
- RELACS has fifteen partners and fourteen linked parties, covering thirteen European countries. The project partners are eleven research organisations, one dissemination partner, and three Small and Medium Enterprises (SMEs). The linked partners are eleven farmer organisations and three research organisations.

Inspiring examples: MAA project



- The multi-actor approach in DEMETER is primarily built on 20 pilots which are active in several European countries and in different agricultural domains.
- The pilots represent key users and also bring their domain knowledge and experience to the iterative development, thus being an active part of the co-creation of the technical solution.

- Thematic network with multi-actor approach that emerged from the endusers needs expressed during an EIP-AGR focus group.
- The NEWBIE network facilitates the development and dissemination of new business models, including new entry models, to the full range of new entrants – from successors to complete newcomers to the agricultural sector.
- The NEWBIE network offers a unique platform by **bringing together new entrants**, **successors**, **advisors**, **researchers**, important regional and national actors and relevant stakeholders in national networks.






Through EURIC, the project selected and awarded 15 Rural Innovation Ambassadors and
