The EU CAP Network - What

- › The EU CAP Network is set up to support the **implementation** of the **CAP Strategic Plans** (Regulation (EU) No 2021/2115)
- › The network is **a forum** for National CAP Networks, organisations, administrations, researchers, entrepreneurs and practitioners **to share knowledge and information** about agriculture and rural policy.
- › Three main objectives:
 - › design and implementation of the CAP Strategic Plans (CSPs),
 - › innovation and knowledge exchange including EIP-AGRI, and
 - › evaluation and monitoring of the CSPs.

- › Brings together stakeholders from the former **European Network for Rural Development** (ENRD), including the **Evaluation Helpdesk**, and **EIP-AGRI** Network and you!

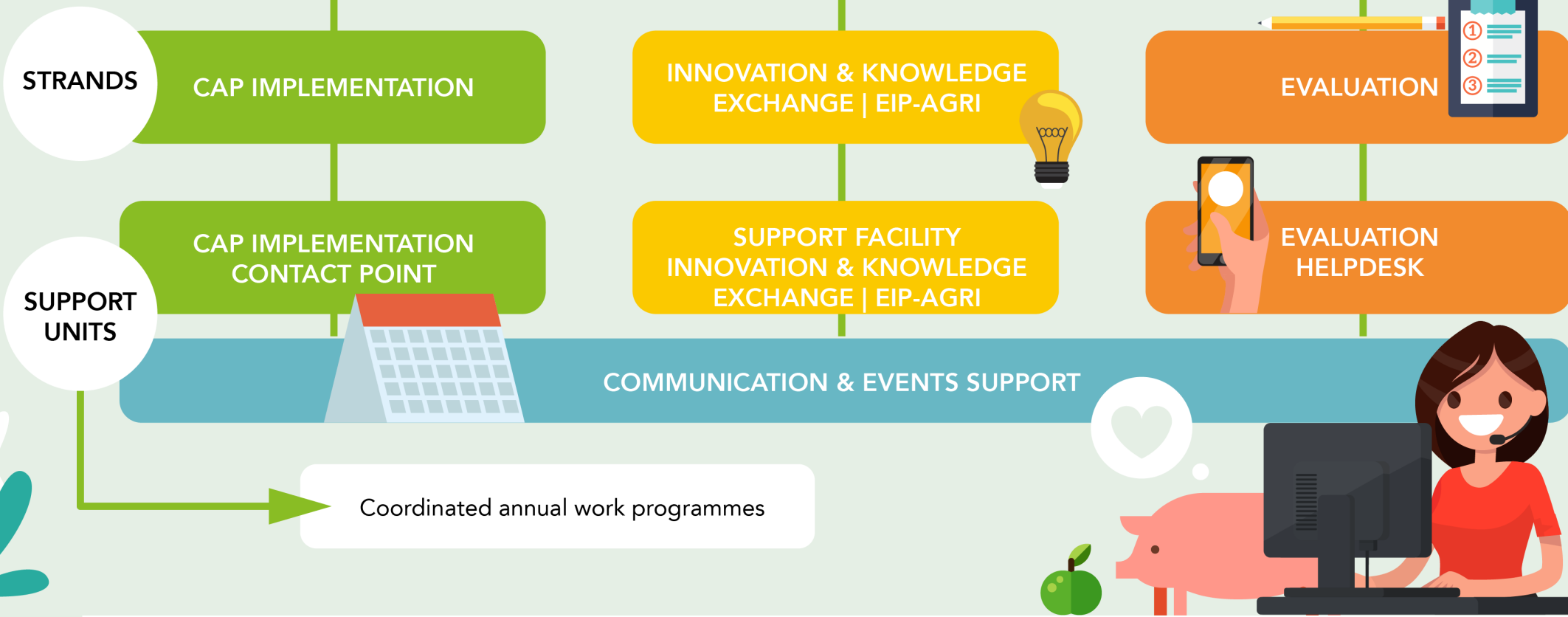

Practitioners (end-users) are put at the **center of the R&I activities** of the project to achieve quicker and bigger impact in practice

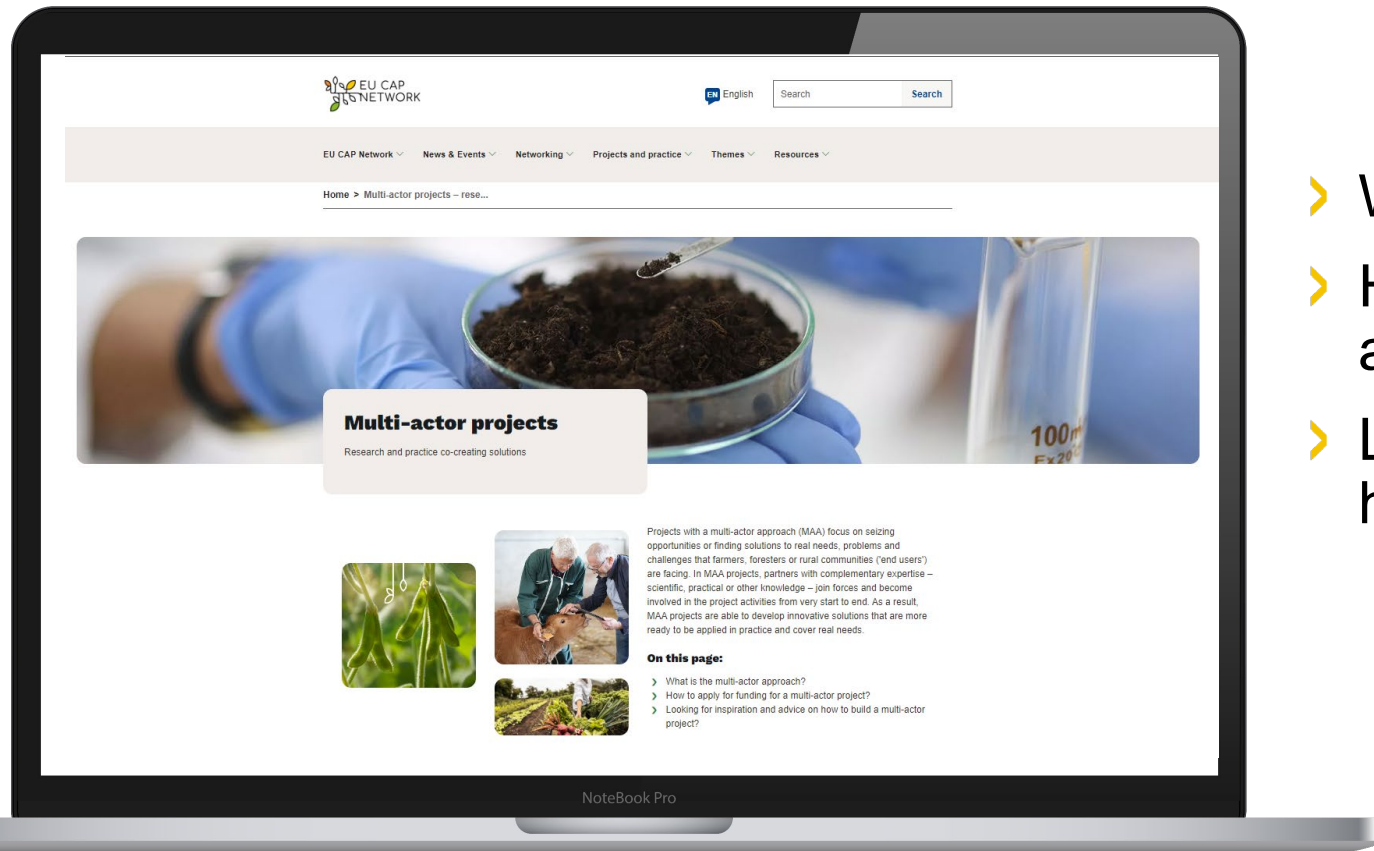
- ✓ *co-create innovative solutions*

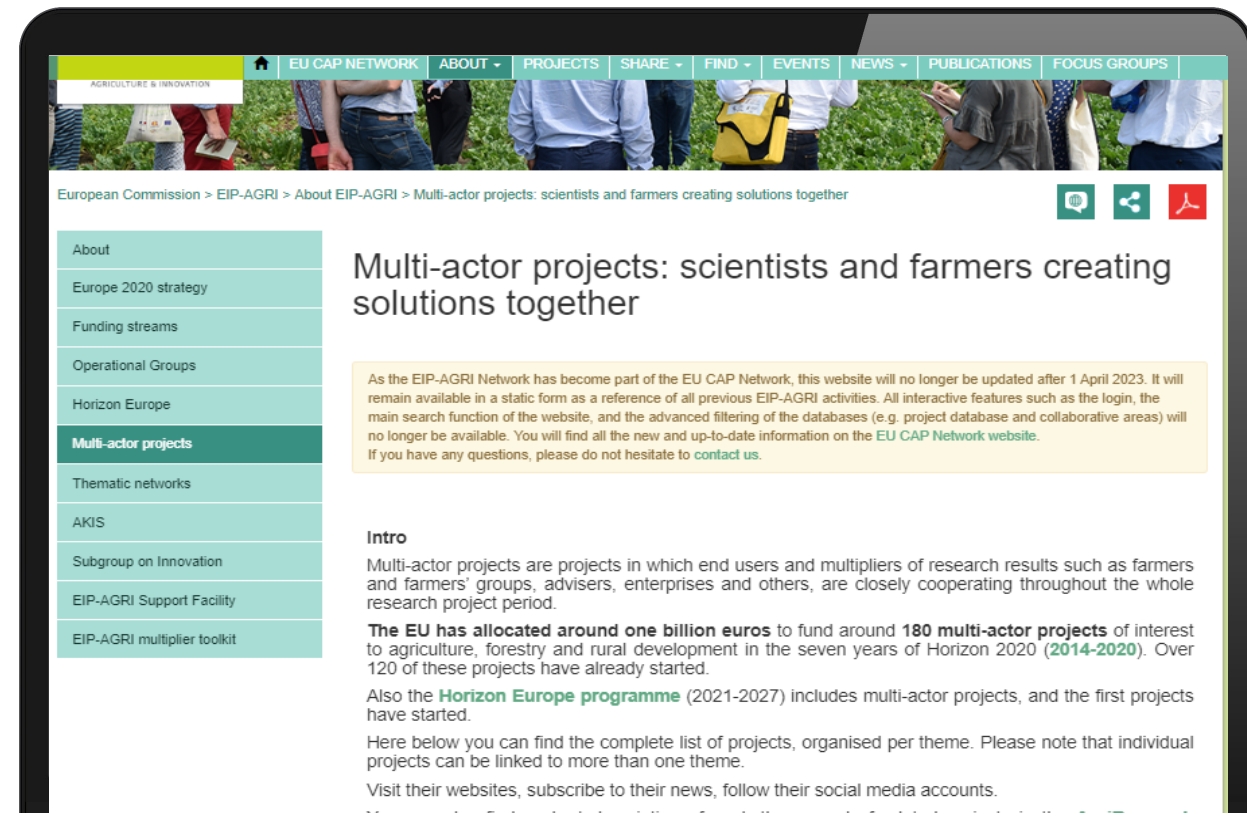

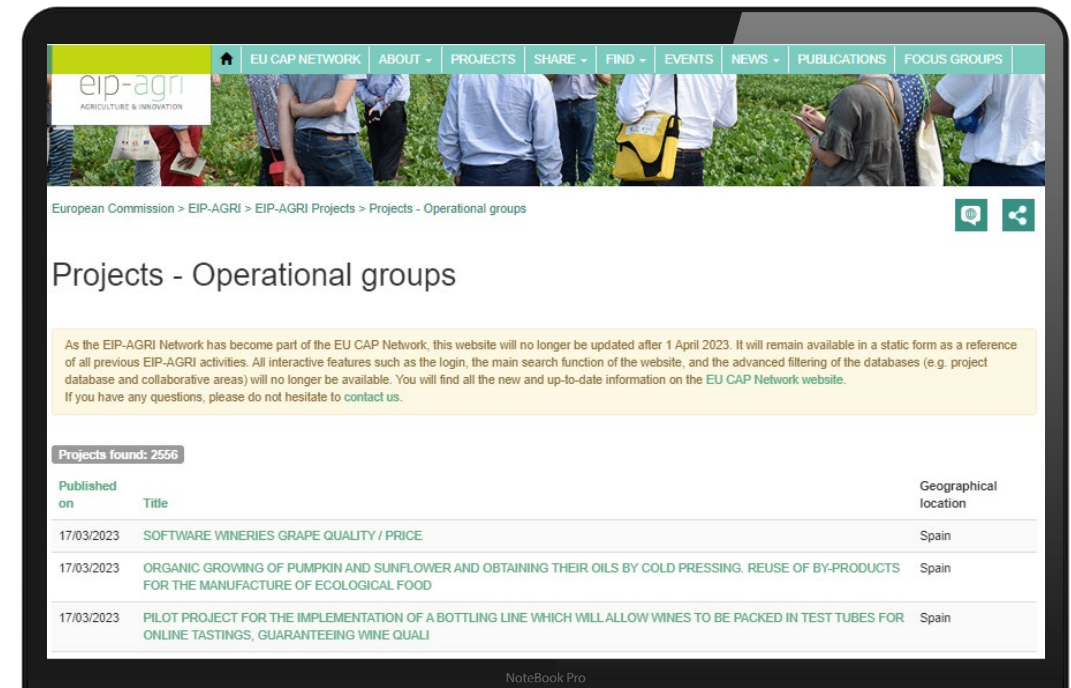
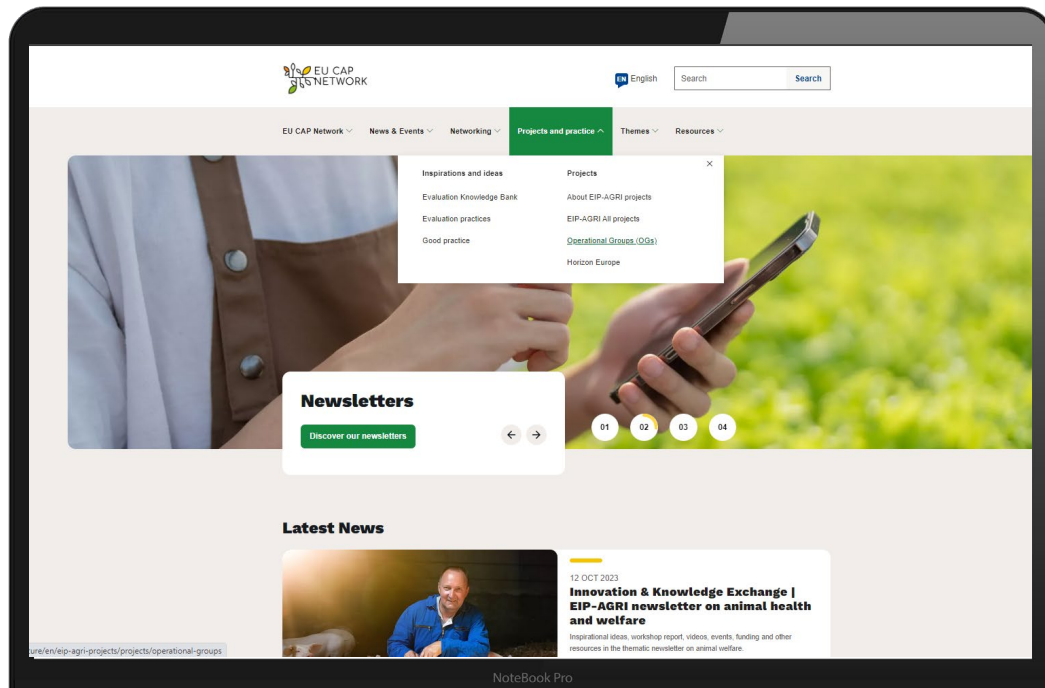
