- The EU CAP Network Brokerage event 'Accelerating the innovation process through Horizon Europe multi-actor projects' took place last week on 19 and 20 October.











Mission Soil: state of implementation



- ≈ EUR 300 million (2021-2023)
- WP 2021-2022
 - 27 signed grants
 - EU contribution EUR 154.2 million
 - Average per project:
 € 5.7 m / 18 partners
 - Success rate (proposals): 28.4%
 - 18.6% SMEs (15% EU contribution)
 - 59.7% HES&REC (70.7% EU contribution)





Roll-out of Mission Work Programmes

WP 2021

Topics on e.g.

soil monitoring and soil health indicators, businesses models for soil health, link between soil health and food quality and safety

> Budget: 67 M€ 11 projects



WP 2022

Topics on e.g. remediation strategies for contaminated sites, soil biodiversity, use of biowaste for soil improvement, carbon farming Budget: 95 M€

17 projects


WP 2023

Topics on e.g. Living Labs (incl. carbon farming), on-site digital tech to monitor nutrients/chemical/biological stressors in soil and plants, soil friendly practices in horticulture, combat desertification

Budget: 139 M€ **Under evaluation**


