

STRONG PUBLIC ADVISORY SERVICE WITH LONG TRADITION

- Operates within the Chamber of Agriculture and Forestry and has a **system of expert groups for individual agriculture areas**, which also includes researchers.
 - Other public services for the implementation of professional tasks in livestock and crop production equally involve the advisory services in the preparation of programs with harmonized objectives, as well as in the implementation of professional tasks.
 - From 2023 on, tasks related to **Innovation Support Services** are defined more precisely in the yearly working plan of advisory service.



THE MAIN CHALLENGES:

- strengthening the financing of research activities, including infrastructure and equipment
- Better exchange of knowledge and innovations from the research sphere through consultancy into practice
- Better cooperation and coordination of all AKIS stakeholders

HOW TO MEASURE THE EFFICIENCY AND PERFORMANCE OF AKIS:

Development and establishment of a system for measuring the effects, impacts and results of the AKIS system



Better integration and cooperation for the exchange of knowledge and innovations between the stakeholders of the AKIS system is essential:

- We encourage **development networks**, consortia of knowledge institutions and other AKIS stakeholders, pilot (test) projects for checking solutions in a real environment, transfer of knowledge with an emphasis on EIP projects, demonstrations (e.g. through demonstration farms), peer-to-peer learning between farmers.
- Special attention is devoted to the **training of** agricultural and forestry advisors.
- Innovative forms and methods of knowledge transfer will be encouraged; also strengthening the online platform - the knowledge portal.

EIP OPERATIONAL GROUPS in Slovenia

Data on the implemented EIPs:

67 operational groups received support in RDP 2014-2020, of which **32 EIP projects** are finished.

Highlighted topics of EIP projects in RDP 2014-2020 are related to:

- climate change
- nature conservation and preservation of biodiversity
- sustainable soil use, soil fertility and sustainable plant protection
- high-performance & sustainable agricultural production, smart & precisely farming

Future plans:

- strengthening the role of farmers in the EIP projects
- better transfer of knowledge into practice and higher dissemination rate
- first open call is planned for January 2024

In 2023 we have set up 11 innovation brokers in the Public Agriculture Advisory Service, who are accessible regionally.

REGIONAL WORKSHOPS WITH FARMERS!

This represents the first step in development of ISS within the framework of the **CAP network**.

New CAP OG Intervention: Development of multi-actor partnerships of research institutions - consortia



Strengthening scientific research institutions in the field of agriculture in areas with gaps in knowledge (and their equipment), which will help the transition of agriculture to green, digital and climate neutral.

NAME OF THE PROPERTY OF THE PROPER

Consortia will connect all key stakeholders working in the AKIS knowledge chain (knowledge hubs) in a particular field or sector:

- public research and educational institutions,
- public services in agriculture,
 veterinary and plant health,
- agricultural advisors,
- representatives of farmers organizations and associations, including demonstration farms,
- etc.

The main idea: Support for equipment that will be used by all partners but under the condition that knowledge exchange, cooperation & ISS will be ensured within the consortium.






