




SPRING23 tune up your network - strengthen your R&D funding

Local Food Day 9.9.2023

- There were 314 destinations, more than 70 000 visitors, a new record!

- The opening event was held in town Huittinen. The main speaker was the Minister of Agriculture and Forestry, Sari Essayah. The program also includes e.g. the panel of MPs from Satakunta region.
- Local food day goals:
 - Create a national rural open-door day from Local Food Day
 - Make visible where the food comes from and how it is produced
 - Lower the threshold between the buyer and the producer
 - From National Local Food Day to the whole of Finland, a holiday dedicated to domestic food
 production and the countryside

 - Digital skills, mobile services, local energy solutions, self-service shops, automatisation, circular economy, security...

Youth Leader activities

- Youth Leader offers young people both funding and activities! Many LAGs in Finland have their own Youth Leader –working groups consisting of local youth.
- The Youth Leader funding is for 13-25 year olds to implement their own projects and business experiments. The youth working group affects the development of the region from the perspective of young people.
- Over 50 young people from 18 LAGs all over Finland got together to celebrate national Youth Leader Days 2023. During the weekend young people and their contact persons working in the LAGs got together to further develop activities and network.



FALL23 Campaign on Business Ownership Transitions



- The Nationwide Business Transfer Forum hosts a themed week focusing on ownership transfer from diverse perspectives in a nationally and internationally organized event, which we participated in.
- Our goal was to raise awareness about ownership transitions in rural areas and highlight that there is EU rural funding available for these changes.
- We conducted a social media campaign, using influencer marketing, national social media channels, and regional communicators' own social media platforms. Additionally, we created a landing page for all the information needed.
- Only through micro-influencers, more than 25,000 people were reached organically. Successful outreach to a diverse audience, including men.

CAP communication in three levels

3. Wide network

An open network that welcomes people from all stakeholders who communicate on rural development issues.

2. Communication network

Rural communication coordinators (15 in total, working in the regions)

1. National CAP communication team

Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry, Finnish Food Authority and Rural Network Unit

Regional communication, planning and coordination between LAGs , regional authorities and municipalities. Weekly meetings together.

The network is a forum for sharing and exchanging common rural communication news. The network meets a few times a year. *The communication network* has common communication strategy, as well as common tools and communication channels, for example a social media management tool (Relation Desk), Canva for photo editing and the websites rural.fi and ruralnetwork.fi, which everyone can update.


