The EU CAP Network - What

- The EU CAP Network is set up to support the implementation of the CAP Strategic Plans (Regulation (EU) No 2021/2115)
- The network is a forum for National CAP Networks, organisations, administrations, researchers, entrepreneurs and practitioners to share knowledge and information about agriculture and rural policy.
- > Three main objectives:
 - > design and implementation of the CAP Strategic Plans (CSPs),
 - > innovation and knowledge exchange including EIP-AGRI, and
 - > evaluation and monitoring of the CSPs.



The EU CAP Network - Who

> Brings together stakeholders from the former European Network for Rural Development (ENRD), including the Evaluation Helpdesk, and EIP-AGRI Network and you!







The EU CAP Network - How



Supports the implementation of the CSPs by:

- > providing opportunities for networking and knowledge exchange among European actors
- > sharing information, including good practices and funding opportunities
- supporting the uptake of innovations in agriculture and strengthening AKIS
- involving people interested in agriculture, forestry and rural areas across the EU

European Innovation Partnership for agricultural productivity and sustainability (EIP-AGRI)

- > Launched by the Commission Communication in February 2012
- Aim: to stimulate innovation and improve the exchange of knowledge
- > **Approach**: Closing the innovation gap between research, innovation and practice by:
 - > using the interactive innovation model (EIP-AGRI Operational groups)
 - > linking actors via the **EU CAP Network** (broad range of networking activities and events)



Operational Groups (OGs) – a key part of EIP-AGRI

- EIP-AGRI OGs are based on the interactive innovation model:
 - > a 'bottom-up' approach to innovation, focusing on actual needs from farmers, foresters or rural communities that require an innovative solution
 - bringing together partners with complementary knowledge – a multi-actor approach
 - > co-deciding and co-creating all along the project
