The Irish Paying Agency presented their eco-scheme system. They established an agrienvironmental scheme that rewards farmers for undertaking actions beneficial to climate, biodiversity, water quality and environment.

The Austrian MA presented their agri-environmental programme 'OPUL'. It integrates basic requirements and top-up payments. National Networks agreed that an effective communication strategy on Eco-scheme and Green Architecture is essential to have an actual good impact on farmers and motivate them to participate in these schemes.
