

Thematic Cluster on CAP monitoring and evaluation

Cluster members exchanged experiences about evaluation activities developed by Member States within their National CAP Network framework during the past and current period.



A common agreement was that farmers should be involved in evaluation activities such as their participation in surveys or understanding their thoughts from evaluation results.

Discussion focused on how to disseminate evaluation plans by the National Networks (activities, methods, and targets).

Member States were asked to share their experience regarding the activities they performed on evaluation - how they made the selection of the participants and their number or which criteria they chose for the selection on a regional basis.

This cluster tries to identify other Member States that are working on an evaluation manual for the National Network



There was an interest in getting more detailed information on the organization of training for LAGs on the topic of evaluation.

There is an interest in a manual for evaluation, similar to the manual for evaluation on AKIS.



Potential collaboration among the Swedish CAP Network, the Evaluation Secretariat (Swedish Managing Authority) and the EU CAP Network was discussed.



The question of whether the Common Network Statistics (CNS) should be the basis for the evaluation of CAP networks was raised.
