



Thematic Cluster on Rural youth & generational renewal

Spain presented the activities with young farmers and young people living in rural areas that they have been implementing in the past years and their plans for the future

Portugal presented their Agrijovem2023 initiative focused on Rural Youth and generational Renewal

Youth LEADER coaches hired by a LAG. Around 25% of the Swedish LAGs have a youth coach, a similar concept to youth activators in Finland. There is a very strong concept of youth in Swedish LAGs

Land Jugend (Rural Youth organisation from Austria)
presented its activities on youth.
This organisation is working on topics, such as democracy, gender equality, reward system for nonformal education, and youth advocacy

Swedish NN presented the Youngagement concept. The target group is 16-25 years. It creates a meeting place where youth can be given tools and inspiration for improving their situation in rural areas.
