

EIP-AGRI


- Launched by the Commission Communication in February 2012
- Aiming to stimulate innovation and knowledge exchange
- Approach: Closing the innovation gap between research, innovation and practice by:
 - using the interactive innovation model (EIP operational groups)
 - Iinking actors via the EU CAP Network/innovation and knowledge exchange strand (broad range of networking and communication activities)

Purpose of ad-hoc meeting

- To help identify key challenges, questions or needs to tackle, from a specific geographical/regional perspective, and to provide input to prepare the call texts of 3 new focus groups:
 - 1. New plant protein sources / production of protein or leguminous crops under climate change
 - 2. Local plant genetic resources in view of climate change and biodiversity loss
 - 3. Alternative strategies for sustainable livestock systems
- To build up networks of national experts in specific fields
