Horizon Europe Cluster 6

Horizon Europe <u>Strategic Plan 25-27</u> was published in April 2024. The SP will steer EU research and innovation funding 2025-2027, addressing the key challenges including sustainable agriculture. The SP announces the creation of a new co-funded <u>European Partnership on Forests and Forestry for a Sustainable Future.</u>

Work Programme 23-24 amendment calls close 8 September 2024 and includes three relevant topics for agriculture:

✓ HORIZON-CL6-2024-FARM2FORK-03-1
Spotlight on plant priority pest: fall armyworm (Spodoptera frugiperda)

✓ HORIZON-CL6-2024-CLIMATE-02-1
New knowledge and innovations for climate-smart farming - connecting research stations

✓ HORIZON-CL6-2024-GOVERNANCE-02-01
European Partnership of Agriculture of Data



The second Horizon Europe strategic plan will steer research and innovation funding within and beyond. Europe, to tackle the kay global challenges such as climate change, pollution and loss of biodiversity, the digital transition and an ageing population.

From fundamental research to breakthrough innovation and deployment of innovative solutions, the strategic plan directs investments into the green and digital transition, building a more resilient, competitive, democratic and inclusive Europe.

To ensure it is fit for purpose, the strategic plan has been developed together with the Member States, Associated Countries and the European Parliament through extensive exchanges including a large public consultation and a citizens' engagement event. The evidence for the strategic plan is based on the <u>Strategic Plan Analysis</u>.




EU Mission Soil : state-of-play (1)

19 new projects selected under the 2023 call will be starting between June and October 2024, adding up to the 28 currently on-going Mission Soil funded projects.

including 5 Living Labs projects (meaning 25 new Living Labs) will be soon kick off their activities









EU Mission Soil : state-of-play (2)

New call for the 2024 Mission Soil Work Programme now open!

9 topics on: soil erosion, nitrogen fluxes, soil health and pollinators, soil biodiversity, healthy crops, carbon farming, and forest peatsoils, establishment of Living Labs, and cooperation for soil health in Africa.




Recurrent request to feed results of EIP-AGRI OGs (and other projects) into the EU-FarmBook platform!
