
State of play Operational Groups





OGs in the database


- > CAP 2014-2022: 3493 OG projects



National Networks have been busy in their key support roles helping to inform the implementation of CAP Strategic Plans through capacity building and knowledge exchanges.

National Networks (NNs) in Portugal, Romania and France became fully operational recently and, as with the other Warnber State NNs, their survices are supporting a range of capacity building and awareness raising activities for CAP Strategic Plane (CSPs) across rural Europe.

Sharing good practice approaches to CSP implementation continues to be strengthened by the NNs through clusterbased approaches. NNs continually improve and evolve this CSP networking technique via their groupings of both

in the regional NN clusters, members have been discussing the new Common Network Statistics and awapping updates on national thematic activities. For instance, the NN thematic duster on monitoring and evaluation in learning from each other about differences and complementantly between national approaches.

NN members of the frematic cluster auggoring efforts to implement the EU's Long-term Vision for Rural Ansas (LTVRA) have recently been exchanging on different national approaches, while the Finnish Network created a dedicated webpage 📑 fo increase awareness about LTVRA topics. The online studen meeting also discussed useful developments with other EU funds that are vital for enabling the LTVRA's success. Considerable potential exists for more complementatity on this that can be progressed as part of the NNs increasing need to coordinate with Rural Pact support services.


Rural youth remain an important resource for achieving LTVRA goals in all Member States and so irredvement of our NN cluster focused on youth helps provide additional complementarity for the LTVRA. Representatives in the youth duster have been exchanging on apportunities for CSP support for Smart Villages and youth involvement. A recent input to the cluster from Estonia showed the other Member States how they can cooperate with the EU's Ensures and Soldarly Fund. 


