

There are over 31 Leader LAGs that offers Youth Leader Action – either funding or other influencing activities or both.







Introduction

- The Youth Leader fund started back in 2010 in 2 North– Ostrobothnian Leader groups for supporting youngster's own project ideas
- Right now 21 of the Finnish LAGs have a Youth Leader fund or youth activities
- The network around Youth Leader and youth activities in Finnish LAGs started to built up about 3-4 years ago
- In 2021 we founded the Coordination group





Introduction

BACKGROUND

- The idea behind the Youth Leader fund is to be able to give a concrete tool for the local youth aged 13-29-years to develop their home area.
- With the fund they are able to start or develop activities they find important.
- Because of the Youth Leader fund we are more able to engage youngsters in our own development strategies and include them in our decision making processes.

WHAT IS IT?

- Youth Leader fund provides financial support for the local youngsters own projects.
- Young people aged 13-29-years can apply for the fund to organize an event or buying hobby equipment. Young people can also apply the fund for implementing their own business ideas.
- The rules and the amount of the fund varies within different Leader-groups. Approximately youngsters can apply projects for 100–1000€





Youth Action Groups

WHAT IS IT?

- With the Youth Action Groups we want to offer diverse possibilities to young people living in the area to get involved in rural development. Youth action groups are politically and religiously independent.
- Leader youth action groups are open for all youngsters that are interested in developing their local rural areas or in decision making.
- In the youth action groups youngsters evaluate the Youth Leader fund applications. In some groups youngsters are engaged in rural development without the fund. 12 Leader LAGs have youth members in their decision making board.





Youth Action Groups

YOUTH INVOLVEMENT

- The focus is on the participation of young people.
- Cooperation with municipal youth work, schools and other organizations/associations/LAGs is important for reaching young people.
- Also in Leader funds the Youth Action Group is included in decision making about projects that are involving young people.



International youth actions

WHAT?

- The younsgters are generally interested in international actions and are a very good target group to work with and for in international cooperations.
- Youth cooperation can be funded by Leader or from other funds, like Erasmus+.
- 17 Leader LAGs implemets international cooperation that includes youngsters. Finnish LAGs have cooperated with Germany, Romania, Scotland, Poland, Spain, Sweden, Italy, Estonia and Latvia.








The group consists of Leader youth workers and the idea is to produce training and information for the network.

In the group, we also think about current issues together and share experiences.


The group includes 10 Leader groups, which initially wanted to develop Youth Leader.


