

- New database launched December 2023 on the EU CAP Network website
- Around 3000 EIP OG projects and 500 research and innovation projects including Horizon multi-actor projects
- To be regularly updated with new projects funded under CAP 2023-2027 and Horizon Europe
- 374 projects in the database working on 'circular economy, incl. waste, by-products and residues ('project keyword')








OG projects – state of play




The EU CAP Network - What


