<u>GRASS CEILING project</u> aims to support the development of a context where women can drive socio-ecological transitions, that is, develop innovations in response to socio-ecological challenges and strengthen the resilience of rural areas.

The online <u>European Policy Forum for women-led innovation</u> in agriculture and rural areas plays a key role in pushing for change and increase women-led socio-ecological innovations in farming, the rural economy and in rural communities.

Following the integrated transdisciplinary and multi-level approach of the project, the Forum aims to mobilise stakeholders and provide a space to foster impactful dialogue, between project stakeholders and the wider community of external actors, that goes beyond sharing results. It is coordinated by Copa-Cogeca and AEIDL (European Association for Innovation in Local Development).

In addition, AEIDL leads the work package focused on co-creating recommendations and tools for enhancing women's participation in the sustainable development of agriculture and rural areas within policy and knowledge and innovation systems. Its objective is to assist policy makers, women innovators, and other actors involved in the innovation eco-system, to repair the gender-bias of relevant policies, tools and governance frameworks.

Objectives of the session

These session aims to:

- introduce the GRASS CEILING project and current findings to key external actors;
- present the project methodological basis for the development of the policy recommendations and tools;
- raise awareness of the European Policy Forum for women-led innovation in agriculture and rural areas, its planned activities and possibilities to be engaged;
- enhance the exchange, learn and interact with key stakeholders regarding policy strategies for gender equality;
- establish contact points with key stakeholders facilitating their engagement.
