GAJNA

- Floodplain pastures along the Sava river, Natura 2000 area
- 250 ha (in LPIS), 180 LU
- Managed by Pasturing community

Management of Gajna grassland

 Members (18) are owners of the livestock (autochtonous breeds) but not of the land

• State-owned land, managed as commons, leased via State Water company, management plan, approved by the MoE

• Per ha payments paid to *Pasturing community*, divided to members acording to the individual number of livestock

73.01. Investments – Non-productive investments in agriculture for nature and the environment

- **1. Construction of terraced parcels**
- 2. Construction of external dry stone walls
- 3. Hedge planting
- 4. Removal of invasive species from agricultural land (one-time investment)
- 5. Purchase of electric fence (areas of large carnivores)
- 6. Purchase of indigenous shepherd dogs (areas of large carnivores and islands)
- 7. Construction/renovation of simple shelters for livestock (areas of large carnivores)
- 8. Restoration of habitats important for biodiversity conservation
- 9. Restoration of traditional ponds (for livestock)
- **10. Purchase of land**
- 11. Planting/restoring poplar alleys for the protection of the European Roller (*Coracias garrulus*)

Eligible applicants for 73.01. investments

- 1. Farmers
- 2. Public institutions for the management of the nature protected areas
- 3. Environmental and nature conservation NGOs

Eligible funding amount per project: 400 – 15.000 EUR 2014-2022 – 94 projects, 6,5 mil EUR
