- ✓ Digital innovation and data technology network for rangeland livestock farming systems (DIGI-Rangeland)
- ✓ Thematic European rural bioeconomy network (thERBN)

- ✓ Connecting Operational Groups across borders to enhance farmers' ability to assess, adopt, and integrate Smart Crop Farming technologies (TECHCOACH)






Mission Soil dashboard





Mission Soil Manifesto
