Led by <u>AEIDL</u>, the EU multi-actor working group <u>first workshop</u> was held on 23 May 2024, bringing together over 60 participants from 21 countries, representing diverse backgrounds. This workshop aimed to present and discuss the current <u>BEATLES project</u> results linked to the policy development.

On the back of the <u>Political Guidelines</u> for the next European Commission 2024-2029, the <u>final report</u> of the Strategic Dialogue for the Future of Agriculture and the upcoming Vision for Agriculture and Food, **this second EU multi-actor working group workshop aims to co-design solutions and EU policy recommendations to expand Climate-Smart Agriculture (CSA) towards 2030 and 2040.**
