#### Assessment of simplification of the CAP

#### **Achievements...**

- ...gathered <u>71 stakeholders</u> to discuss the assessment of simplification of the CAP
- ...carried out an analytical study on simplification and administrative burden for farmers (publication in 2025)
- ...explored the <u>assessment of results-based interventions</u> and their potential to simplify the administration of the CAP (publication in 2025)







#### Assessing the climate contribution of the CAP

#### **Achievements...**

- ...gathered 89 stakeholders to discuss assessment of the contribution of carbon farming to CAP climate objectives!
- ...reviewed <u>55 MS evaluations</u> related to climate change mitigation/adaptation and summarised lessons
- ...assessed the climate change mitigation potential of <u>28 CAP Strategic Plans</u>
- ...trained 180 stakeholders in using coefficients to calculate rough estimates of the CSP climate change mitigation potential!

#### Metrics and stakeholders' data at a glance


- The survey was shared with 26,010 contacts.
- According to SurveyMonkey, for such a number of contracts,
   379 responses are needed to get a representative sample at a
   95% confidence level with a 5% margin of error.
- The annual survey received 805 responses, more than the double of the minimum needed to consider its results may thus be considered representative.




#### Number of followers on all social media platforms




Platforms used and where would you like to receive info about EU CAP Network

#### **Evolution of publications quantity (Y1-Y3)**








