Subgroup on Innovation and Knowledge Exchange (SolKE)

- Exchange on use of results from EU CAP Network events in Member States
 - National focus groups on topics from EU CAP Network activities (e.g. Austria)
 - SolKE members learn from each other, deepen contacts and organize **knowledge exchange activities** (e.g. cross-visit Italy-Flanders on advice and administrative aspects)
- Study on outcomes achieved by EIP-AGRI Operational Group (OG) projects
 - 65% of OGs fully met the objectives
 - Main drivers and barriers for successful co-creation of innovative solutions:
 - Key: OG composition: mix of relevant complementary expertise, partners' motivation, effective coordination
- Actions for follow-up and uptake of OGs outcomes
 - Knowledge circularity approach and multi-actor approach (Horizon Nutri-Know)
 - Living lab scaling up outcomes of OG (Portugal)
 - E.g. Right partners in OG to spread outcomes, post-project support to scale op results
- Information on latest developments on EIP-AGRI and Horizon Europe
 - Request to feed results of EIP-AGRI OGs into the **EU-FarmBook** platform = digital platform to support agricultural sector by providing best practices
