> DESCRIPTION OF THE CASE (CONTEXT)

- Long tradition: more than 150 varieties, such as "Blue apple" or "Champagne-Renette
- Decrease of the number of trees by almost 70 % (since 1960)
- Regional value network and a regional fruit beverage brand in the Hesselberg region: "hesselberger"
- 1500 producers and around 170 points of sale and restaurants for orchard drinks

- Conservation and care of landscape with valuable ecosystems and high biodiversity.
- Grassland contribute to a good soil water balance and a CO2-storage
