Objectives of the seminar

Main objective: Promote the use of on farm-demonstrations (OFD) as an essential tool for peer-to peer learning, the setting up and visibility of demonstration farms as well as to foster their networks and connections.

Specific objectives:

- Highlight best practices in the organisation & facilitation of OFD
- Discuss challenges and opportunities for setting-up, financing, operating and managing of demonstration farms/their networks, and embedding them in the AKIS structures
- Explore the role of OFD during and in the follow-up of EIP operational groups and Horizon projects'
- Derive lessons: what is missing/can be improved to reach scale and harness the full potential of OFD and demonstration farms

Agricultural Knowledge and Innovation System (AKIS): on-farm demonstrations an integral part



AKIS connects actors in a structured way and on a regular basis to create continuous interaction with the aim to speed up knowledge exchange and innovation

CAP support for on-farm demonstrations/demonstration farms

28 CAP Strategic Plans 2023-27:

- A description of the organisational set-up of the AKIS
- Support for on-farm demonstrations/demonstration farms under type of interventions Art. 78 Knowledge exchange and dissemination of information
- Decision of Member States in line with identified needs and strategy
- As stand-alone intervention or part of the intervention supporting training activities



CAP Strategic Plans 2023-2027: support for onfarm demonstrations/demonstration farms

Intervention	Percentage of total public funds (EAFRD + national)
Knowledge exchange and dissemination for information (Art 78, KNOW)	1,9 %
EIP operational groups (Art 77, COOP)	1,5 %
All AKIS interventions (Art 77+ Art 78)	3,4 %





European Innovation Partnership for agricultural productivity and sustainability (EIP-AGRI)

Launched by the European Commission in February 2012

Aim: Speed up innovation in agriculture and make it more sustainable and productive

How:

 Support farmers and foresters to develop practical innovative solutions together with a targeted group of complementary partners

 Provide opportunities for networking and knowledge exchange, including better connections between research and practice

Bottom-up approach to innovation

focusing on actual needs from farmers, foresters or rural communities that require an innovative solution


EIP operational groups and on-farm demonstrations

- Operational groups (OGs) obliged to disseminate summaries of their plans and results of their projects (Art 127)
- EU and national CAP networks also have to disseminate plans, but especially results of the OG projects
- OFD can serve as an excellent tool to disseminate innovative solutions and new knowledge
- OFD activities can be included in the dissemination plan of the OGs with dedicated budget

Types of partners in OG projects (2014-2022)




On-farm demonstrations can play a major role:

Data on OGs: Number of OG projects in the EU






Data on OGs: Funds used


Total budgets per MS in 2014-2022 & 2023-2027
