






HISTORY OF LAG RegioL


- founded in 1992 → MIAR
- renamed to RegioL for first application for LEADER
- LEADER Region since 2007 (3rd period)
- regional development: 30 municipalities (45k inhabitants)
 - beyond in form of cooperation projects
- apart from LEADER:
 - Interreg programme Italy & Austria "Terra Raetica"
 - Regional economic development (by federal province Tyrol)
- "One-Stop-Shop"
 - Fundings on federal, national and european level





TRANSNATIONAL project experiences

- Projekt Partner: Växlust Värmland | southern Sweden
- Innovation & Economics consulting & Qualification programme for digitalization
- Three workpackages:
 - Smart Innovation Manager in both regions
 - Digital innovation resource programme
 - Transnational exchange
- Duration: 01.01.2019 31.12.2021 (extended)
- Volume: € 80.000,-
- Funding rate: 80 %



NATIONAL project experiences

- Activation of vacant properties in Tyrol
- 9 out of 10 LAGs in Tyrol
- Consulting in the field of vacant properties with a project consultant for Tyrol
- Duration: 01.01.2024 31.12.2025 (2 years)
- Volume: € 108.000,-
- Funding rate € 80%



NATIONAL project experience

- Nature parc rangers Tyrol
- 5 out of 10 LAGs in Tyrol
- Education programme for nature parc guides
- Installation of sustainability experts for all nature parcs in Tyrol
- Duration: 01.04.2024 31.03.2026 (2 years)
- Volume: € 81.027,30
- Funding rate: 80%



LESSONS LEARNED

- Especially transnational collaboration is fundamentally initiated by workshops – Cooperation corner is best practice
- Collaboration is crucial to foster innovation in rural regions (Pechlaner et al., 2008)
