- › **Date & Location:** 07 October 2025, Brussels
- › **Participants:** 154 stakeholders from 26 Member States (Managing Authorities, farmers, advisors, evaluators, DG AGRI)
- › **Purpose:**
 - › Share early experiences with CAP Strategic Plan implementation
 - › Identify challenges and practical solutions
 - › Strengthen stakeholder ownership and collaboration
- › **Key Activities:**
 - › Panel discussions on CAP delivery and national experiences
 - › Interactive sessions on six topics: environmental/climate payments, climate adaptation, competitiveness, advice & knowledge tools, digitalisation, processes & actors
 - › Proposals for quick wins and long-term actions for post-2027 CAP

> Cross-cutting conclusions:

- > Simpler, faster, and more predictable delivery mechanisms
- > Capable, impartial advisory services close to the farm
- > Farmer-centric data systems — interoperable, privacy-respecting, and designed for practical use
- > Incentives must reflect local realities, backed by stable, long-term funding
- > Address administrative burden and payment delays, trust deficit, and unequal access and capacity

> Forward-looking proposals:

- > Ring-fenced funding for advisory services and training
- > Long-term, results-based agreements (10+ years)
- > Eco-scheme participation as a baseline
- > Complementary incentives (green loans, labels, tax relief)
- > Farmer-controlled data ecosystems and rural connectivity
- > Trust-building governance and policy stability
