Towards a competitive protein crops production in Europe

The focus group on protein crops held their first meeting September 12-13 in Oss, the Netherlands. They agreed on their main task: to find ways to increase the EU production of protein crops in a competitive and sustainable manner. The discussions were framed by a starting paper, which had been circulated to the group's members in advance.

During the meeting the 20 experts explored:

- the present status of local protein crop production
- which alternatives would be available to meet the current and future demand
- which innovations/changes would have the largest impact

All members are now gathering information and ideas on projects and operational groups on 8 themes, to be shared during the next meeting in January.

The eight themes are:

- 1. Breeding chain and genomics
- 2. Yield improvement and stability
- 3. Transition: developing or adapting a value chain
- 4. Crop diversity
- 5. Mixed cropping
- 6. Extension and lack of familiarity with protein crops for farmers
- 7. Diversification of the livestock chain
- 8. Sustainability and transparency demands
