

RDPs 2014-2020: Monitoring data - EU Overview

Situation at the end of 2021

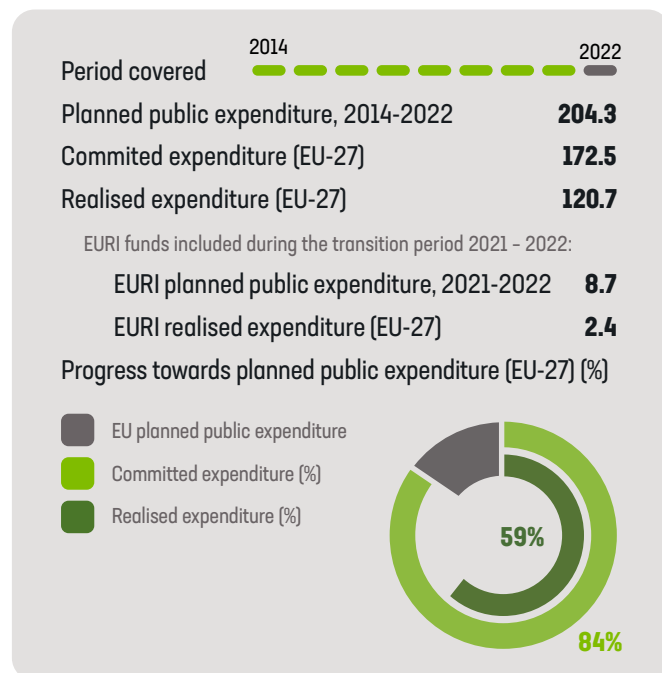
This factsheet contains monitoring data aggregated at EU level (EU-27), providing a comprehensive overview of the state of play in the implementation of the EU rural development policy. In particular, Section 1 presents financial expenditures¹ including the additional funds from the European Recovery Instrument (EURI). The data are aggregated at EU level and broken down by Rural Development Priority, covering the period between 2014 and end 2021. Section 2 presents the progress realised towards EU common target indicators.

1. Financial expenditure (EU-27)

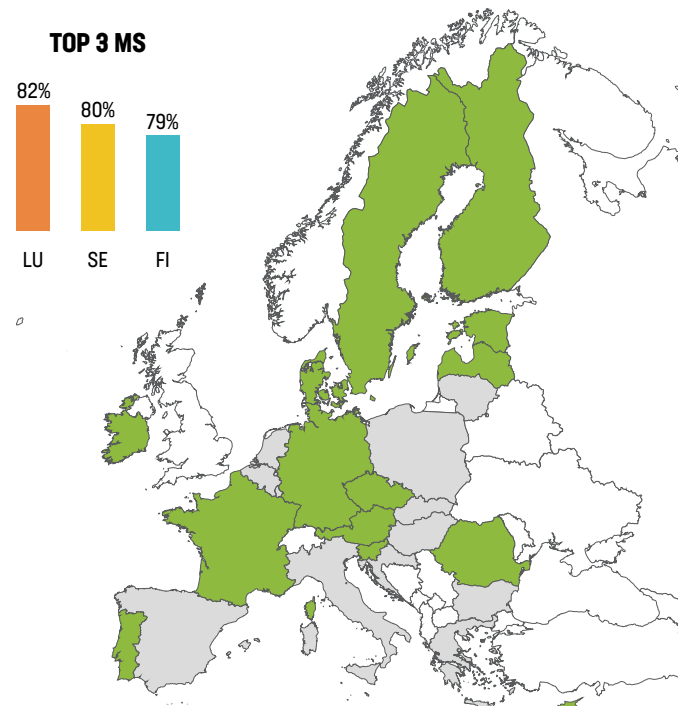

This information includes planned, committed and realised expenditures, and the progress made towards achieving the EU planned expenditures.

Map 1: Member States with progress towards planned expenditures above the EU average of 59% (based on realised expenditures).



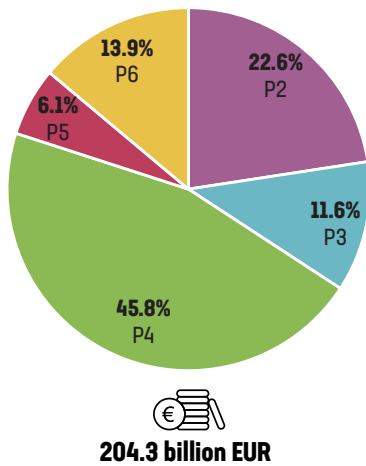

- ii) **Realised expenditures** are related to all those operations that have been completed and the last payment made.

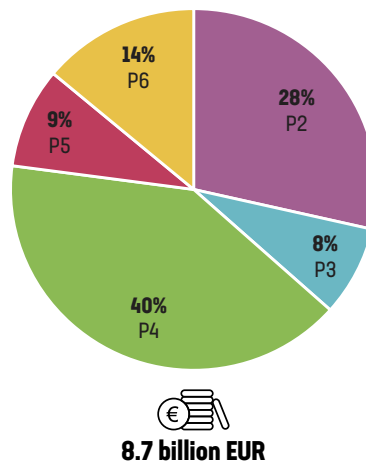

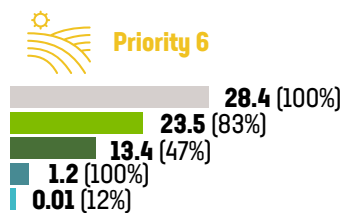
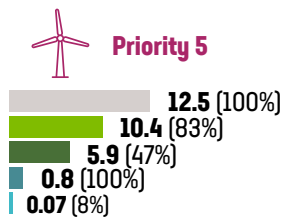
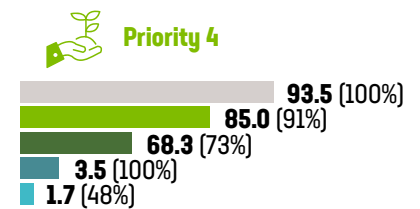
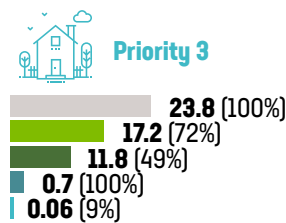
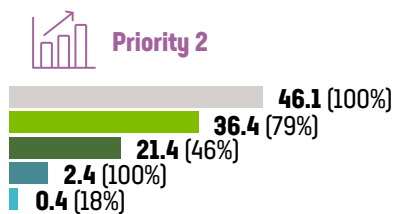

Source of information: All data presented in this factsheet is collected from the Annual Implementation Reports (AIRs) submitted by Member States to the Commission by the end of June 2022. Data was retrieved in January 2023 from the 2022 AIRs. Exceptionally, the EURI planned expenditure is based on the latest adopted RDPs on 17 March 2023, while the EURI realised expenditure is based on declarations of expenditure up until Q4 2022.

In this factsheet, public expenditure means total public expenditure (= EAFRD + Member States matching funds + any national top-ups). Due to rounding, there may be small discrepancies between some figures presented. Data illustrated cover the programme implementation period between 2014-2021.
